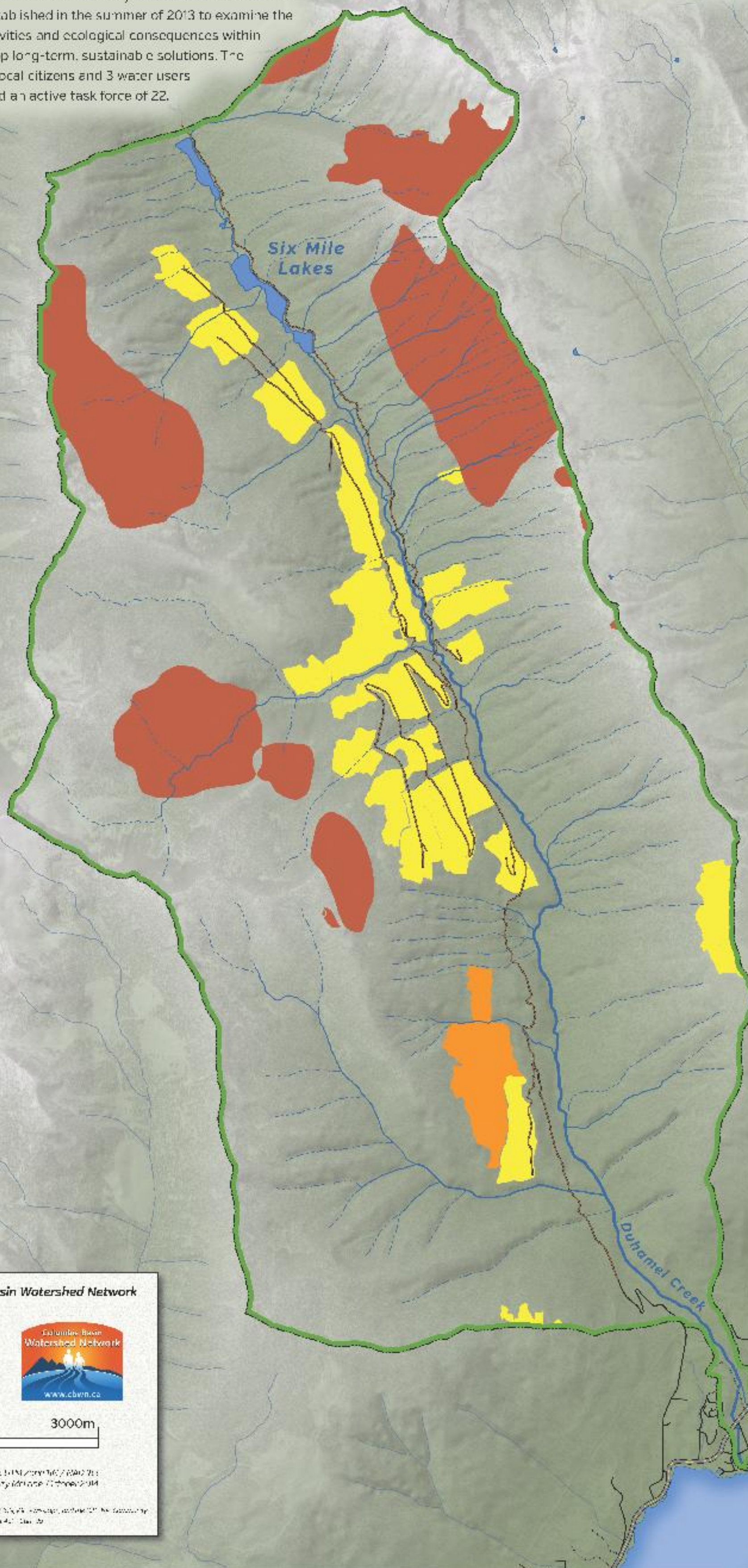
About the Duhamel Watershed Society

The Duhamel Watershed Society is an organization of community members from the North Shore and Nelson areas. The society was established in the summer of 2013 to examine the relationship between land management activities and ecological consequences within the Duhamel Creek watershed and to develop long-term, sustainable solutions. The membership consists of approximately 100 local citizens and 3 water users groups; which total over 200 water users and an active task force of 22.
