Now, our grants normally range from around \$500 to a pretty well maximum figure of \$2,500, and the average grant in recent years has been of the order of \$1,500. In addition, we have an unusually high number of applications in for this spring, so I fear that a number of worthwhile projects will have to be rejected and many others will not receive the full amount they are seeking. In these circumstances I think the Committee may feel that it would not be worthwhile to recommend a partial grant for you if it would not enable you to complete the project. Are there no other sources of funds to which you could look for support ? I would be grateful if you could review the position during the next few weeks and if you could let me have some further comments by March 31 I could present the letter with your application to the Projects Committee which meets in early April.
