*A \$10,000 grant is sought from Canada Council, so far, unsuccessfully.*

*Selkirk College has submitted for fiscal funds to cover the year 75/76 but anticipates little or nothing available.*

*Mr. Barton has now provided \$55,000 in capital outlay & materials, but has no further resources for operation, development or subsistence.*
